- Lecture Plans and Teachers' Daily Diaries: Each teacher designs Lecture Plans based on recommendations from the Board of Studies and maintains a Teachers' Daily Diary to record daily activities and progress.

2. Assessment and Evaluation

- Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and Semester End Examinations: The tentative schedule for internal assessments and exams is outlined in the Academic Calendar.
- Examination Time-table: The Examination Committee prepares and publishes the time-table for exams well in advance, ensuring clarity and transparency.
- Internal Assessment: The assessment process follows the guidelines set by University Statutes, ensuring timely and accurate evaluation.


